



## ELKHORN CAMPUS FAQ

**Q: What are the services times?**

A: Just like our Millard Campus, service times will be 9:00am and 10:45am.

**Q: Who will be delivering the message?**

A: Most of the time, the message will be a live simulcast from our Millard Campus. Occasionally, Campus Pastor Brad Zook will be bringing the message live. There will be a live worship band each week.

**Q: What age groups will have Children's Programming?**

A: Like our Millard Campus, kids programming will be for all ages – birth through 8<sup>th</sup> grade. There are a lot of classrooms and group spaces.

**Q: What will be offered for Youth (Middle School and High School)?**

A: Like at Millard, Tribe will meet during 2<sup>nd</sup> service (10:45am). Beginning in January, we'll offer Wednesday Night programming for both Middle and High School. We encourage High Schoolers to get involved in Student Impact on Sunday mornings – serving throughout the building in various roles, just like at Millard.

**Q: What does being on the Launch Team mean?**

A: The Launch Team is committed to the Elkhorn Campus for roughly two years. Specifically, they have committed to the following:

1. Attend regularly on Sunday mornings.
2. Serve regularly (approximately 8:15am – 12:15pm, attending one service and serving one service.)
3. Give regularly.

**Q: How many Millard attenders do you need to be on the Launch Team?**
